Key Policy

Policy

To ensure key holders are aware of club rules, policies and safety requirements while using the club ranges, keys will only be issued to members that have gone through a range orientation and safety procedure session, on all ranges, with one of the individuals authorized to provide such orientation, listed below.

Keys cannot be lent out to non-members under any circumstances without Board of Directors approval. Failure to abide by this policy will result in revocation of your membership.

Procedures

- Each new member (or non current member, which is defined as a member that did not hold a membership in the previous calendar year) will be issued a temporary membership card. It will be their responsibility to arrange the "range orientation and safety procedure session" directly with one of the authorized individuals below within one month of becoming a member (weather/season permitting).

- Once the above safety training session is held, the Range Safety Officer will inform the Membership and Key Chairpersons. The Key Chairperson will only provide a key to a "temporary member" after being informed that the training session has been completed or to a member that holds a "current" membership card.

Key Eligibility

- Only paid members are allowed to obtain a gate key.
- Only members who have participated in the above safety orientation/training are eligible to receive a key.
- For Family Memberships, multiple keys can be obtained, but each key must be signed and paid for.
- Any individual wanting a key must pay for the key.

Key Cost

- \$5 per key

Note: When at the Range it is mandatory that members wear their membership card.
