MEMBERSHIP POLICY & BENEFITS

Membership Fees

Membership fees are set annually at the AGM by the membership.

The current rates are shown on the club membership application form; and are also posted on the web site at www.lowgc.ca

- Single membership (18-64 years of age)
- Family membership (includes spouse and children <21 years of age, living at home and in school full time.
- Senior membership (individual >64 years of age)
- Junior membership (individual <18 years of age at the time of renewal)

Membership Expiry Date

December 31st of each year

(please note that the Lake of the Woods membership may not necessarily coincide with the CSSA membership expiry date on the back of the CSSA membership card)

Benefits

- Membership allows you unlimited access to the club ranges unless the ranges are closed for a special event or when club ranges are rented by another organization, such as the O.P.P. . The ranges include:
 - Handgun range (bullseye, PPC, silhouette, plates)
 - Rifle range (bench rest, score shooting, metallic silhouettes)
 - Shotgun ranges (Trap shooting , Sporting Clays)
- Membership allows you to bring a guest to the club to experience the facilities and participate in a club event or organized shoot.
- Membership provides savings on the purchase of shotgun shells and trap/sporting clay rounds (over what guests/visitors of the club receive)
- Membership provides you the opportunity to participate in all club events and compete for trophies during the seasonal windup events
- Membership allows you the opportunity to participate in the Annual General Meeting (October each year) and to be a member of the Board of Directors to help govern/operate the club
- Membership also provides you a membership in the Canadian Shooting Sports Association (CSSA) which:
 - Provides you with a quarterly newsletter/magazine from CSSA
 - Provides you with important \$5,000,000.00 per incident insurance coverage which includes worldwide recreational shooting including hunting activities.(please review the policy coverage shown on the CSSA web site for more details, exceptions and disclaimers)
- Membership provides the opportunity for social activities, camaraderie, an outlet to relieve stress and best of all, to access experienced club members, to improve shooting skills, techniques and knowledge
- Membership provides a safe shooting environment, which beats shooting in a gravel pit.
- You don't have to clean, skin and eat everything you shoot like you do when you're hunting.
